XWARN nets are held on the first Monday of every month at 7:30 P.M. on XWARN repeater 147.165. We will switch net controls so new people can try it out.



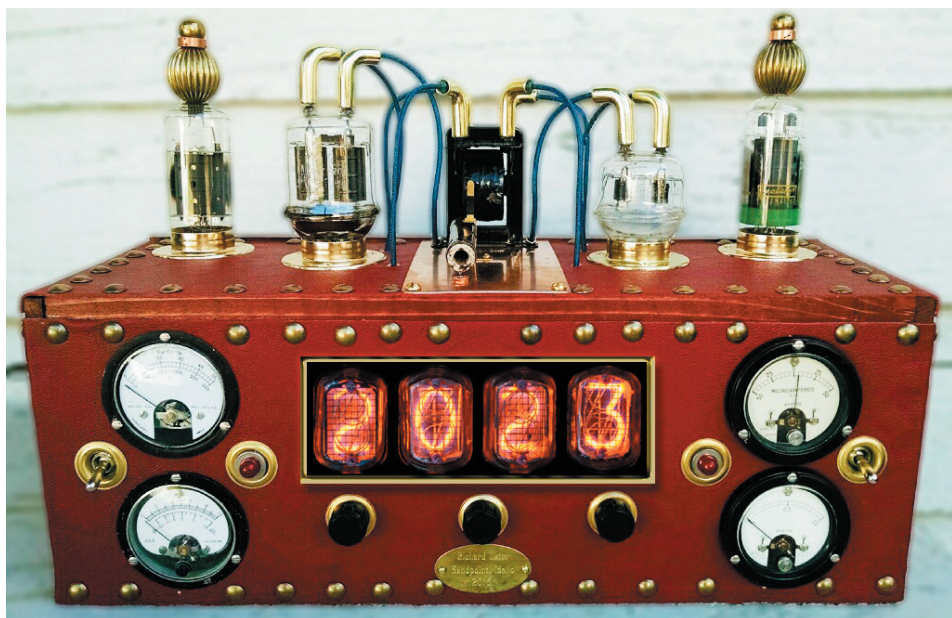
WAVELENGTHS
